- Administrator Bolden reemphasized the mandated 1% HBCU/MSI goal in an agency-wide memorandum
- New FY2016 Office of Small Business Programs Pilot Initiative, in collaboration with the Office of Education and Space Technology Mission Directorate
 - Designed to assist NASA and Large Prime Contractors meet and/or exceed the mandated HBCU/MSI goal through the Mentor-Protégé Program
