MAS Consolidation



Phase One

Develop the New Schedule

- ✓ Create a new solicitation for the single schedule
- ✓ Review every term and condition
- ✓ Map duplicate Special Item Numbers (SIN) across the current solicitations
- ✓ Use Category Management to better organize offerings
- ✓ Release new schedule and close existing schedules to new offers

Phase Two

Mass Modifications

- Complete mass modification for all existing contract holders (simply to update terms and conditions)
- Contracts retain current schedule contract number
- Vendors may select SINs that were previously on separate schedules

Phase Three

Multiple Contract Consolidation

- Consolidate multiple contracts into a single contract for those contractors

MAS Consolidation Phase I Impacts



Who and what are impacted?

- New offerors
- New Solicitation went live on October 1, 2019
- eOffer
 - Prior to October 1, 2019
 - No impact to completed offers submitted by this time. Complete and responsive offers will be awarded under legacy Schedule structure.
 - Offers in progress and not submitted by September 30, 2019 will need to be restarted under the new solicitation structure, prior to submitting.
 - After October 1, 2019
 - All offers will be completed and submitted under the new solicitation.



MAS Consolidation Phase I Impacts



Who and what are not impacted?

- Who
 - Current contractors won't be impacted until Phase II
 - No action for current contractors under Phase I, but the solicitation will be a preview for what they can expect in the mass mod set for issuance in January 2020.
- What
 - eMod
 - Current contractors will be allowed to submit mods throughout MAS Consolidation
 - eLibrary
 - GSA Advantage
 - eBuy

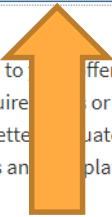

Available Offerings and Requirements

The Multiple Award Schedule (MAS or the Schedule) is broken into Large Categories, Subcategories, and Special Item Numbers (SINs) that have corresponding North American Industrial Classification Codes (NAICS).

To identify the large categories, subcategories, and SINs that may apply to your company, please view the [Available Offerings Attachment](#) [XLSX - 365 KB].

The MAS solicitation outlines requirements for all offerors, including the required information you must attach to your offer to be considered for a Schedule contract. In addition, some large categories, subcategories or SINs have unique requirements or additional templates and attachments that may be required as part of your offer. This additional information is used to better evaluate your offer and confirm you are ready to do business with the Federal government. Below is an outline of the attachments and templates that you may be required to submit with your offer.



For more information on the applicability of each template or attachment, please refer to SCP-FSS-001 under section I of the MAS solicitation and each applicable "Large Category Attachment" related to your offerings. In addition to specific attachments, there may be clauses or additional instructions specific to your offerings outlined in those documents.

Templates, attachments, and critical information referenced in the solicitation are provided below for use. Please reference solicitation documents for further instruction.

Instructions Applicable to All Offerors



Consolidated SCP-FSS-001 Provision

- The new SCP-FSS-001 streamlines, simplifies and improves acquisition performance by:
 - Consolidating basic offeror instructions applicable to products, services, new offerors, successful contractors and TDR participants
 - Eliminating several offeror submission requirements
 - Clarifying existing offeror instructions
 - Prescribing a single simplified evaluation provision

SCP provision identifies solicitation requirements that are completed and/or submitted directly through the eOffer application and what documents must be uploaded by the offeror	Consolidated SCP-FSS-001 links to an Offer Documents Submission Checklist posted on the gsa.gov/masroadmap site which can be updated as necessary
Standard requirement for Service offers is two (2) project experiences per SIN	Standard requirement for Service offers is one (1) project experience per SIN

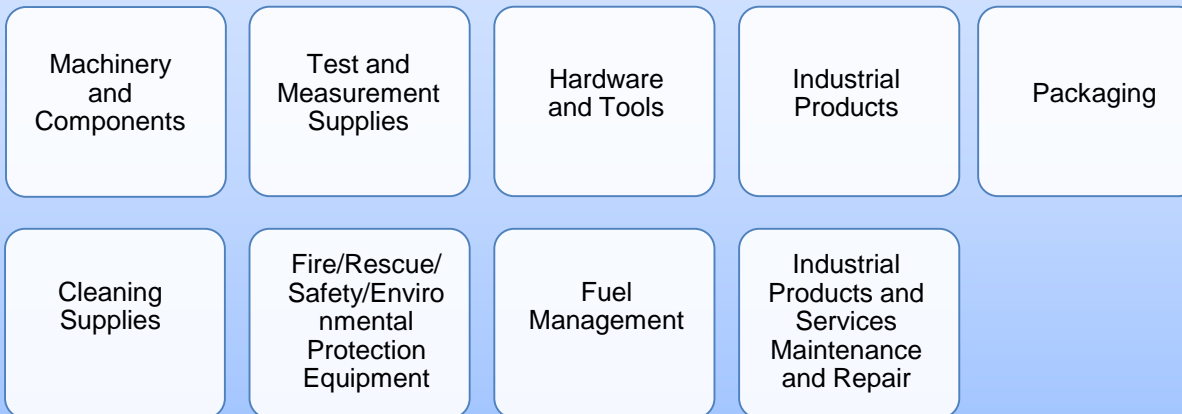
