



# NASA MPP OVERVIEW & UPDATE

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# PURPOSE OF THE NASA MENTOR-PROTÉGÉ PROGRAM (MPP)

To provide incentives for NASA contractors to assist eligible small businesses, as defined in NASA Federal Acquisitions Regulation (FAR) Supplement (NFS) 1819.72, in enhancing their capabilities to perform as prime contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers under Government and commercial contracts.

# MENTOR ELIGIBILITY/PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- Mentor must be eligible for receipt of government contracts.
- Mentor must be approved by the NASA MPP PM...Approvals good for six years.
- Mentor must be a large prime contractor performing under a NASA contract with an approved subcontracting plan.
- No limit on number of agreements a mentor can have.
- Mentors can simultaneously have multiple agreements with various protégés.

# MENTOR APPLICATION – PACKET REQUIREMENTS

- Cover letter on company letterhead.
- M1. Mentor Information - Enter your company's information. If a previously approved Mentor, enter your original
- M2. Eligibility – Prime will need to answer “yes” to being eligible for the award of federal contract and performing under at least one active approved subcontracting plan negotiated with NASA. Include Contract No.
- M3. Historical Background – Provide a brief summary (400 words or less) about the business, profile, historical background, recent activities and accomplishments. Also include whether the business has ever been classified as a Small Businesses.

# MENTOR APPLICATION – PACKET REQUIREMENTS, CONT.

- M4 – Small Business Prime and Subcontracting Goals – Provide a 3-year trend analysis of company’s small business prime and subcontracting goals and actuals. If no previous NASA data, Prime can provide goals and actuals from another agency.
- M5 – Mentor Performance Data
  - A. Prime Contracts – List the number of prime contracts awarded from NASA and other Federal agencies along with associated dollar values for all prime contracts received by the first for past two GFYs. If none, enter zero.
  - Subcontracts – List the number of NASA subcontracts and other Federal Agencies along with the associated dollar value for each for the past two GFYs. If none, enter zero.

# MENTOR APPLICATION – PACKET REQUIREMENTS, CONT.

- M6 – Ability to Provide Development Assistance – Describe the Mentor’s ability to provide developmental assistance and include how the assistance will potentially increase subcontracting opportunities to SBs or HBCUs/MSIs.
- M7 – Summary Subcontracting Report (SSR) – Attach a copy of the SSRs for the two preceding GFYs. If new to NASA, Prime can provide SSRs from another agency.
- M8 – Signature

# PROTÉGÉ ELIGIBILITY/PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- Protégé must be eligible for the award of Federal Government contracts.
- Protégé must be able to certify as small against the NAICS code size standard that represents the contemplated supplies or services to be provided by the Protégé to the Mentor.
- No limit on the number of times a Protégé can participate in the NASA MPP, but only one agreement at a time (applies only to past NASA MPAs since January 2008).
- In those situations where Protégés have participated in past MPAs, the developmental assistance received from Mentors cannot be duplicated.
- Protégé must be classified in one of the business classification types in order to participate in the NASA MPP.
